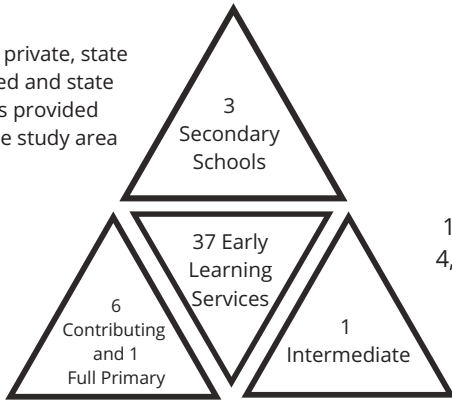


# Current Education Provision

Enrolment schemes allow Boards to manage potential overcrowding in schools.

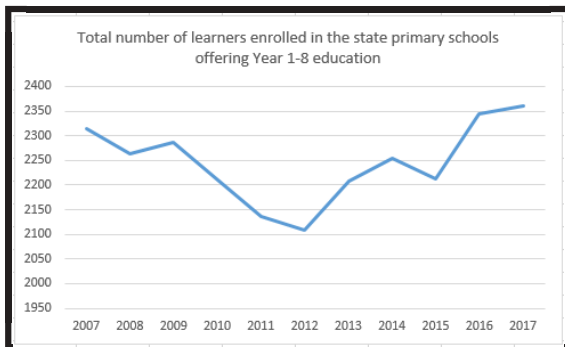

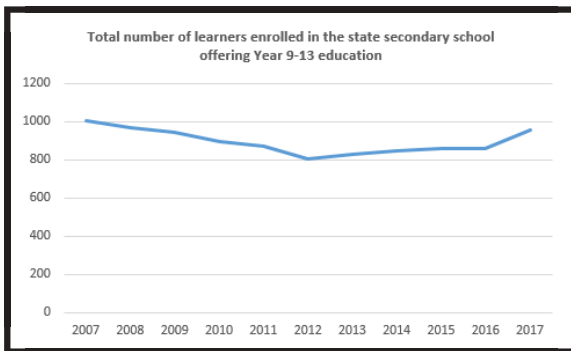

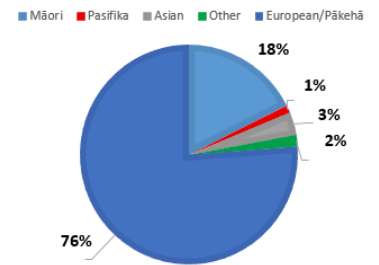

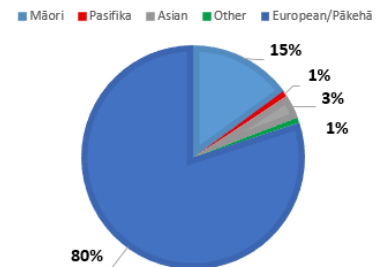

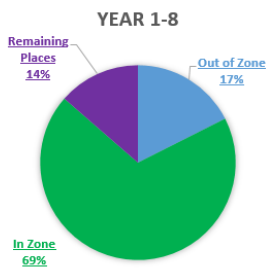
### ETHNICITY YEAR 1-8



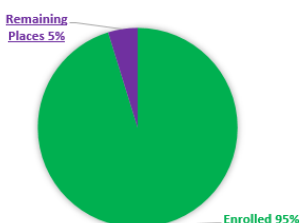
### ETHNICITY YEAR 9-13

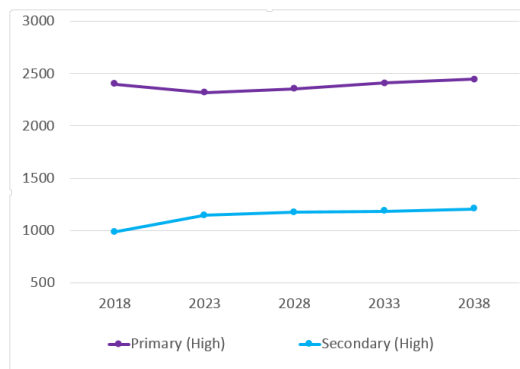

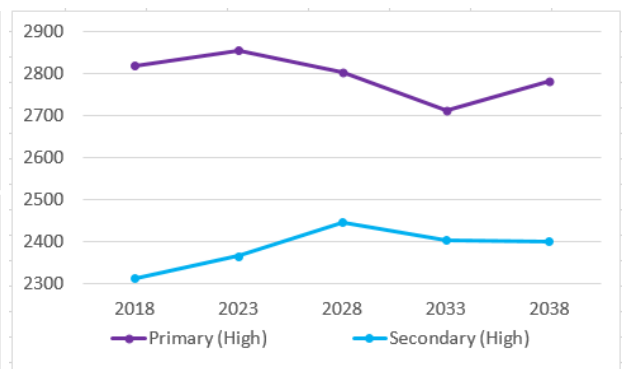
## Projected Roll Growth
